This is the reason why we are gathered here today, as the actors of these quest, as designers of an Art that involves every aspect of our lives. The clothes we wear, the buildings we live in, the music we listen to, the medicines we take, the books we read—all that would be inexistent, if it wasn't for the creative capacity of human beings.
