Dear parents:

We hope you had a restful family vacation. We are very happy to inform you that we are ready to return to campus. The School Administration, together with government authorities, our external biosafety consultant, Hemisaro Salud, and our Medical Department, have developed a Progressive Return to Classes Plan for the 2021-2022 school year.

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Our goal is to maintain the maximum protection, safety and health of our students, teachers and administrative staff. At this time, 99% of our staff is vaccinated.

We want to share with you the criteria that we have considered for the design of our Progressive Return to Classes Plan:

- Health and security
- Student learning
- Student welfare
- Capacity and well-being of our teachers
- Updated research
- Experience from other schools
- Characteristics and needs of the FCAQ Community.
- Regulations in force by COE, MSP and MINEDUC

As you know, our PICE (Institutional Plan for Educational Continuity) has the proper authorization, so we are ready to return to campus under the Hybrid Mode (face-to-face and virtual). We will start classes with the allowed capacity and the capacity will be increased in accordance with the provisions of the Ministry of Education. We will continue to offer the virtual learning option for those families who choose this modality.

Group I Fully In-person	Includes Nursery, Eleventh and Twelfth grade students exclusively.	They will attend face-to-face classes on campus every week.
Group II Hybrid: In-person and Virtual	Includes students from Preschool, Primary and Secondary through Tenth grade.	They will attend classes alternately, that is, one week in person at the school and the next week at home under the virtual model. The groups will be divided by the first letter of their surname based on capacity.
Group III Full Virtual	Includes students from Nursery through Twelfth grade who choose the virtual model.	They will attend virtual classes every week from Monday to Friday.

I invite you to review again the different class schedules by modality. This information can be found in the Back to Campus Manual, posted on the school's website.

Before saying goodbye, I would like to kindly request that you inform us of your decision regarding the return of your children to campus. It is important that you complete the following survey by following the link at the end of this communication and uploading the authorization document to return to class. The survey must be completed by Thursday, August 19 at 3:00 p.m., in order to continue with the planning required to implement the Return to School Plan.
